- None of the dogs making up these entries judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Stud Dog Class: To be entered in Stud Dog Class and shown with no less than two (2) nor more than 4 of his get. Get need not be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes. Awards will be entirely on the merits of the get. As the Judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed (Variety) by virtue of having one this class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above, except for the following two changes: Substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", and substitute "Produce" for "Get".

Brace Class: This shall be for two dogs with identical ownership. Dogs comprising a Bruce MUST be named at time of entry. If entered for Brace Class Only full particulars must be given for each dog entered on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes.

NON-REGULAR (NON-COMPETITIVE) CLASSES

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS: is for Doberman Pinschers that are American Champions, Field Trial Champions, AKC Obedience Title Holders and dogs that have earned a Working Dog Title from the AKC. Parade MUST be indicated on the entry form. Please include information about your Title Holder with entry form. Information should be limited to 1 side of a typed 4x8 card sent in with entry. All entrants receive a Rosette with the Dog's name printed in gold on a streamer..

PARADE OF RESCUE DOGS: is for Doberman Pinschers placed through a rescue organization or acquired from a rescue situation. Each participant will receive a Rosette with the Dog's name printed in gold on a streamer. A typed 4x8 card with the dog's accomplishments or story to be sent in with entry.

AWARDS OF MERIT: Depending on the entry, the club will offer certificates and Rosettes to be awarded after the judge has awarded BOB. Awards of Merit may be given at the judge's discretion to the Remaining deserving animals; no more that 2 awards to be given.
